Just 35 metres in length, *Coral Expeditions II* is the ideal small ship for discovering the World Heritage-Listed Great Barrier Reef and small enough to allow snorkelling directly from the ship

The 21 onboard rooms are fully equipped with a private ensuite, air conditioning and ample storage space, as well as large picture windows, allowing you to fully immerse yourself in the spectacular scenery.

The ship features a spacious lounge with cocktail bar, comprehensive reference library and plasma screens. The large sun deck offers comfortable deck chairs and teak furnishings. Meals are served in the dining room, with space for all guests to dine during one sitting and no assigned seating.

Coral Expeditions II operates an Open Bridge policy, allowing you to spend time with the Captain and his maritime crew as we cruise.

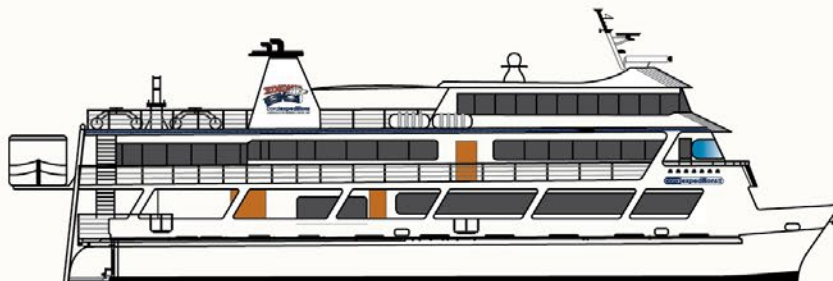

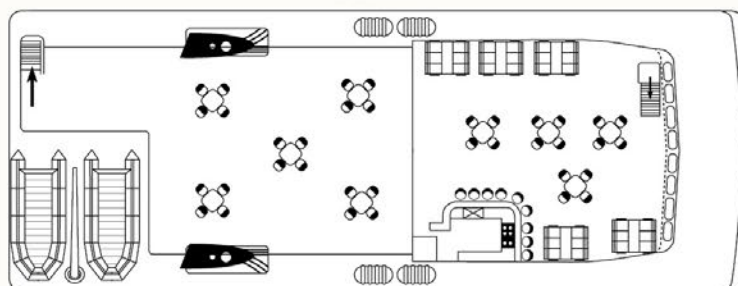

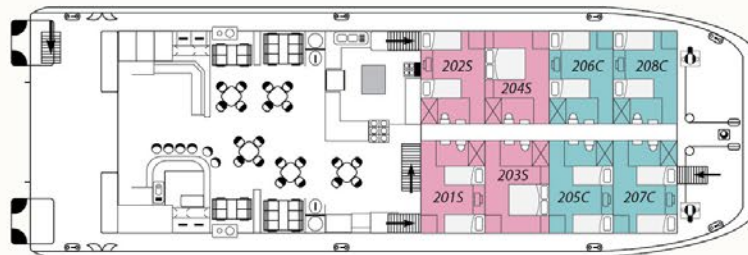

STATEROOMS & CABINS



DELUXE STATEROOM

Our four Deluxe Staterooms are located at the stern of B Deck, in close proximity to the Bridge and the full length Sun Deck. This room also features comfortable settee, desk and bluetooth dock compatible with all devices.



UPPER DECK STATEROOM

Our nine Upper Deck Staterooms are located on Deck B, a dedicated accommodation deck offering a quiet environment, yet still in close proximity to the Bridge, Sun Deck and Dining Room. A bluetooth dock compatible with all devices is also included.



STATEROOM

Our four Staterooms are located midship on Deck C, close to the Dining Room and our Glass-Bottom Boat boarding platform. A bluetooth dock compatible with all devices is also included. Triple share is available in a Stateroom.

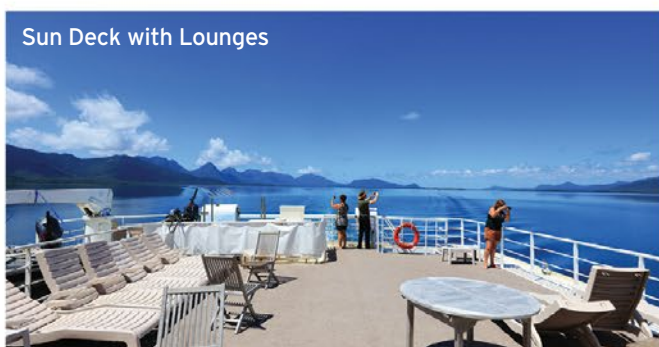


CABIN
