SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

Louis Roederer Brut Premier Champagne NV, France

Delicate, persistent beading. It has a rich yet subtle bouquet with hints of hawthorn, almonds & toast.

NV Nocton Vineyards Estate Sparkling Pinot Noir Chardonnay Coal River Valley, Tasmania

The nose is bright with aromas of fresh-baked muffins & blackcurrant. The palate is dry & firm with lemon pith, mandarin & chestnut which the bright acidity & bubbles take out to a strong, even finish.

Wines

Riversdale Crux Sparkling 2018

Fermented in the bottle according to traditional French methods, this estate-grown Crux sparkling wine is a blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. The palate is driven by single-vineyard Chardonnay, while Pinot Noir adds richness, depth and an element of creaminess to the palate.

Riversdale Chardonnay

A fresh fruit filled palate with tropical fruits balanced with crisp acidity and finishing with good persistence of flavour. Floral, citrus, and herbal notes with nuances of passionfruit & gooseberry aromas.

Riversdale Sauvignon Blanc

Bright, light green hues yield an aroma of floral, citrus and herbal notes. A tropical fruit palate is balanced with crisp acidity.

Riversdale Pinot Gris

A lovely fresh crisp taste to the palate which is bursting with fresh Pear and Apple flavours complimented with sweet spices and perfumed floral accents.

Riversdale Pinot Noir

The palate is full of bright cherry and raspberry fruit flavours with a hint of spice and subtle violet notes. Silky tannins and lively acids add balance and structure to the long, juicy finish.

RIVERSDALE ESTATE

Coal River Valley, Tasmania

Riversdale Estate is located in the basin of the Coal River Valley, in Southern Tasmania. The coal River Valley is the second largest wine region in Tasmania and continues to grow each year as a result of the unique growing climates located in the Valley. Riversdale is located in the basin of the valley and is the only vineyard to front Pittwater, which gives temperature averages during the winter and summer months. Do to the climate advantages, it is able to produce nine different varieties with a reputation for Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Syrah and Reisling. Riversdale Estate was purchased in 1980 by Ian Roberts. The first vines were planted in 1991 and are some of the oldest in the region.
