

COMPLETING YOUR G2G PASS

All states and territories currently have border passes in place and they are essential in order to be allowed entry and for the purposes of health communication and contact tracing. In Western Australia this is the G2G Pass and we recommend it is completed no less than 3 days prior to entering Western Australia or boarding our vessel.

This how-to guide is to assist you with understanding the pass and providing the correct responses in regard to your expedition cruise. Note that a separate application form is required for each individual and requires an individual email address. No 3rd party should be completing this pass on your behalf. Further information can be obtained by reading the introduction on the G2G pass website prior to beginning your application.

HOW TO APPLY FOR YOUR G2G PASS

- STEP 1.** Visit the [G2G Pass Website](#) and select **Western Australia**
- STEP 2.** Ensure you have a digital image of your driver's license, passport or Medicare card at hand, as you will need to upload at least one of these documents to complete your pass application.
- STEP 3.** Note that if you have completed a G2G Pass previously, you may log-in to your account to complete your application more rapidly. If this is your first time you must complete the full process.
- STEP 4.** Select 'I Consent' at the bottom of the introduction page to proceed to the application form. The page provides information on what you are consenting to and its privacy policy. On the next page click 'Continue' to proceed to the application form.
- STEP 5.** Enter your personal details, including details of your next of kin and the names of any fellow travellers
- STEP 6.** Enter your travel details. If you are beginning your expedition in Broome or Fremantle, select that you are arriving by Air. If you are entering Western Australia aboard your expedition ship (having boarded in Darwin or some other port), select that you are arriving by Sea.
- STEP 7.** Select your reason for travel as 'Tourism'
- STEP 8.** Enter the date you are entering Western Australia. If arriving by sea, this is the date you arrive in the port of Broome or Fremantle.
- STEP 9.** Your intended address in Western Australia may be your hotel accommodation. If you have no hotel accommodation you should list the name of the vessel with the address as 401 Port Drive, Broome, WA 6725
- STEP 10.** Your reason for travel is "Travelling to the Kimberley aboard Coral Expeditions."
- STEP 11.** Answer the questions regarding your movements in the last 14 days to the best of your ability. This is important in the event of "hot-spot" developments whilst you are at sea or in transit.

- STEP 12.** To answer the question regarding where you could quarantine for up to 14 days if required, we recommend answering with the name of your hotel accommodation in Western Australia. You do not need to have a booking here to enter these details. Corresponding questions should be answered with the distance from where you enter Western Australia i.e., distance from the airport or port of arrival. In this section you may also enter the address of Coral Expeditions partner hotel, the Continental Broome, Weld Street, Broome, WA, 6725.
- STEP 13.** Upload a digital image of your supporting document that verifies your identity and current residential address. This can be your passport or Driver's License.
- STEP 14.** Complete the Health Declaration.
- STEP 15.** Regarding the final question "Are you currently awaiting a result from a COVID-19 test" - This refers to symptomatic tests. The PCR test required as part of the SailSAFE plan is an asymptomatic test therefore please select "NO". By selecting YES you will experience a decline on your G2G pass and will not be able to resubmit until your test results are received and this will mean you cannot enter WA. Select NO. However, if at anytime before, during travel or after arriving in WA, you do become symptomatic then please follow the current state health advice.
- STEP 16.** Choose a password and keep this handy with your travel documents.
- STEP 17.** We recommend you download the G2G app to your phone in order to monitor any further requirements and the status of your application. Select G2G Now as the final step in your application - [GET THE APP >](#)
- STEP 18.** Submit your application.
- STEP 19.** You should receive a notification when your G2G Pass is approved. This should be kept at hand as it will need to be presented upon your arrival into Western Australia.
